# HOW THE TRADE PROGRAMMES WORK



At Traincorp FET College, our trade programmes combine knowledge training, practical skills development, workplace experience, and assessment preparation to prepare students for qualification and the workplace.

## YEAR 1 TRAINCORP TRAINING

 12 MONTHS FULL-TIME TRAINING AT TRAINCORP



Students complete the following in sequence:



Practical training forms part of the 12 months full-time training completed at Traincorp.

## YEAR 2 & 3 WORKPLACE TRAINING

 2 YEARS WORKPLACE EXPERIENCE



After completing the institutional training phase, students must complete workplace training at an approved company.



### WORKPLACE MODULES

Complete all required workplace modules.



### QUALIFIED RED SEAL MENTOR

Training under the guidance of a qualified Red Seal mentor.



### WORKPLACE EVIDENCE

Maintain logbooks and collect evidence.



### INDUSTRY EXPERIENCE

Gain real industry experience and practical exposure.

## RETURN TO TRAINCORP GAP ANALYSIS & TRADE TEST PREPARATION

 4 WEEKS TRADE TEST PREPARATION



Once workplace training is completed, students return to Traincorp FET College for:

### GAP ANALYSIS



Students complete a gap analysis test to identify areas requiring additional preparation before trade testing.



### TRADE TEST PREPARATION



Students then complete:

- 4 weeks Trade Test Preparation
- Practical revision
- Trade test simulations
- Assessment preparation

Comparing the traditional apprenticeship with the modern Occupational Certificate route.

 <b>ENTRY REQUIREMENT</b>	Grade 12 with Mathematics and Physical Science	Currently Grade 10 with Maths Literacy (moving toward Grade 9 level)
 <b>INITIAL STUDIES</b>	Complete N1 – N3 Engineering Studies (minimum N2 required)	Enrol directly into an Occupational Certificate qualification (NQF Level 4)
 <b>EMPLOYMENT</b>	Secure employment upfront with a registered training provider company	No employment required upfront to start studies
 <b>CONTRACT</b>	Sign a 4-year apprenticeship contract	Complete 12 months full-time study at Traincorp FET College

### WORKPLACE REQUIREMENTS



- EMPLOYER**  
Must be a CIPC-registered company with a valid tax number.
- MENTOR**  
A qualified artisan in the specific trade must act as mentor and sign off the logbook.
- AGREEMENT**  
A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) must be signed between the company and Traincorp FET College.

### TRAINCORP STUDENT MODEL

-  Students are non-contracted (private) students.
-  Students do not fall under government or SETA grant-funded apprenticeship systems.
-  Students follow an independent training pathway supported by Traincorp.
-  Supported through structured training, workplace guidance, and assessment preparation.
